



Last round of the Spanish Trial Championship - Alcañiz

## STRONG WIN BY ADAM RAGA (GAS GAS)

With the Spanish title already in his hands, there is no rival to the manufacturer's rider

Alcañiz, Teruel, 31 October 2004.— The works GAS GAS trial team were able to celebrate Adam Raga's title, which he already achieved at the Trial de Igualada, the last round of the Spanish Championship, with a clear win today. The public that attended the Alcañiz event enjoyed the spectacle of the Ulldecona rider's riding. Raga is at his highest form, and no other rider in the Spanish trial field is close to him at the moment. The other GAS GAS team member, Jeroni Fajardo, was fourth today.

With favourable weather, pleasant temperatures and no rain in Alcañiz, the last round of the Spanish Championship presented sections on dry ground and with high grip. Adam Raga was second on the first lap, with seven points in his account. The GAS GAS man's great performance came on the second lap: Adam Raga did not score a single point, which allowed him to win the overall standings with total clarity. There is not a better possible way to put an end to the season and celebrate the national title.

On his part, the young GAS GAS rider Jeroni Fajardo was fourth today after collecting 11 points on the first lap and 7 on the second one. Behind him were four other GAS GAS riders: Jordi Pascuet, Daniel Gibert, Daniel Oliveras and Dani Cuerdo blocked the places from fifth to eighth in this order.

Another highlight of the event was the new system that has been tested on the final round of the championship, resulting in a tighter competition timetable so as to be able to tackle all the sections in one hour less than what has been usual so far this season.
