

24 hours after winning the Toulouse trial

ADAM RAGA (GAS GAS) WINS AGAIN IN THE WORLD INDOOR TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Granada, 30 January 2005.- The GAS GAS rider Adam Raga has displayed his excellent skills at the commands of his GG TXT 300 again, and has climbed onto the top step of the rostrum at the fourth round of the World Indoor Trial Championship held in Granada today, only one day after his win at the Toulouse round. This is the fourth head-to-head win by the 22-year-old in the world indoor series, showing that he is ahead of his rivals again.

In a race consisting on eight sections on the first lap, ten in the second one, a speed zone and a high jump, the GAS GAS School of Champions rider proved why he is the double world champion before the 4,000 spectators who attended the event in the Andalusian city. *"I tried to rest as much as possible yesterday so as to recover my strength after the Toulouse event, and I managed to be 100% fit and to win the trial. I had a very good first lap, which allowed me to get the best score, opening a gap with my rivals, although they closed it back later,"* commented Raga at the end of the trial.

"I am proving to be physically very fit, which is very hard to keep, so I am just enjoying this moment while I can," added the GAS GAS man. The results show that he is absolutely right.

Another of the GAS GAS School of Champions riders, Marc Colomer's pupil 19-year-old Jeroni Fajardo, finished the Granada event in an excellent fifth position, which allows him to keep the sixth place in the provisional championship standings.
