After his second place at the Trial de Buñol

ADAM RAGA AND GAS GAS, SPANISH TRIAL CHAMPIONS

Buñol, Valencia, 23 October 2005.— The GAS GAS rider Adam Raga, at the commands of his GG TXT Pro 300, has become the Spanish Trial Champion after the celebration of the sixth and last round of the series, which took place in Buñol, Valencia today. With 3 wins (Les Gunyoles, Pobladura de los Regueros and Entrimo), 2 seconds (Mancha Real and Buñol) and 1 third (La Pobla de Segur), the Ulldecona rider has won the Open and Senior A Spanish Championships with great authority and has thus added two other titles to his already complete 2005 tally, which makes him the undisputable number one of trial. GAS GAS has also won the manufacturers' title in the Spanish Championship.

«This is clearly a brilliant end to this season. We are also particularly happy with the high number of GAS GAS riders and for achieving the manufacturer's title, » comments Narcís Casas, the person in charge of GAS GAS. The high-difficulty Buñol terrain saw Raga and Fajardo tackling the sections in the first places: *«The ground was loose and it was important to start at the back, but that wasn't possible and things came out fine in spite of that. I am very happy, it means two more titles in a season which is being extraordinarily good, » stated the GAS GAS rider at the end of the trial. With these two titles, Raga has already added a total of six this season alone, after brilliantly winning his third back-to-back indoor World Championship, the outdoor World Trial Championship, the Trial des Nations (sharing team with Cabestany, Bou and Freixa), and the Gold Medal at the 2005 World Games, with GAS GAS rider Jeroni Fajardo and Marc Freixa. The 23-year-old is winning all the championships he enters, and there is only the Spanish Indoor Trial Championship to go to close the season, a championship where he is presently in the second place.*

This title also completes the successful 2005 season for GAS GAS, proving the positive line of the GAS GAS School of Champions, as well as the reliability and efficiency of the manufacturer's vehicles. For Fajardo, this was his first trial in the Spanish series after the injury he suffered at the start of the season, in what was precisely the championship's opening round.

The next event for the GAS GAS team will be the third round of the Spanish Indoor Trial Championship, which will be held on November 1 at the Palau Fontajau in Gerona.
