At the Trial de Andorra, the seventh WTC round: A win for Dani Oliveras in the Youth Cup

## **EXCELLENT VICTORY FOR ADAM RAGA (GAS GAS)**

Sant Julià de Lòria, Principat d'Andorra, 19 June 2005.— The current Indoor World Trial Champion, Adam Raga (GAS GAS TXT Pro 300), has achieved an important win at the Andorran Grand Prix, held today in Sant Julià de Lòria. After being the most efficient on the second lap, the GAS GAS man's won in extremis before Doug Lampkin (Montesa) thanks to Raga's higher number of cleans.

Already at the end of the first lap the winner was predicted to be among the eventual podium finishers. There were four riders in 3 points: Lampkin, Fujinami, Raga and Cabestany, with three others – Bou, Fajardo and Freixa – also fighting for the honour places in four points. Raga was to be the best in the end, adding another 20 points to his private account and, most important, shortening the gap with the three riders before him in the championship, as he is only two points behind the leader now. Jeroni Fajardo, who was making his comeback, was the second GAS GAS man at the end, in a well-deserved seventh place.

«I am very happy because I have given it all and things came out as expected. It is incredible how tight the standings were at the end, which proves how high the present level is, », admits an Adam Raga who is again on a winning line.

In the Junior class, the win went to James Dabill, with GAS GAS riders Daniel Gibert in the second place and Julien Arnaud in fourth. In the Junior World Championship, Dabill has a comfortable lead with 25 points over the Spaniard. In the Youth Cup 125 class, Daniel Oliveras (GAS GAS) added another win to his account – the fifth of the season – before Matteo Grattarola, Loris Gubian and Alessandro Mondo (GG), so the Spanish rider is leading the World Cup provisional standings somewhat easily.

The World Trial Championship is returning at the weekend with the French G.P., which will be held on a two-day format with the headquarters in Alès, near Montpellier.
