JERONI FAJARDO (GAS GAS), SECOND IN THE TRIAL OF ITALY

Valbondione, Italy, 10 July 2005.- The trial GAS GAS team rider Jeroni Fajardo (GG TXT 280) has achieved to climb onto the second step of the rostrum on the second day of the Trial of Italy, the eleventh round of the World Trial Championship.

The *GAS GAS School of Champions* rider started the day at the top of the ranks after the first lap's 15 sections with just 21 points on his account, ahead of his rivals in a difficult, muddy trial which made things very slippery for the participants and their bikes. His performance on the second lap was enough to give him the second spot in the final standings. On the other hand, his team partner Adam Raga (GG TXT 300) finished fourth, a result which allows him to keep the provisional lead of the outdoor World Championship standings, with 182 points.

In the Youth Cup, Daniel Oliveras (GAS GAS 125) had an excellent performance again. The semi-works GAS GAS rider proved unbeatable and collected yet another win in the eleventh championship round, ahead of Matteo Grattarola, 2nd with 24 points, and Loris Gubian in 3rd with 33. In the provisional Championship standings, Oliveras leads with 214 points, with Loris Gubian (171 points) and Matteo Grattarola (137 points) trailing behind.

In the Junior class, another semi-works GAS GAS rider, Daniel Gibert, came home in the fourth place. The class was won by Briton James Dabill, followed by Italy's Francesco Iolitta and the Spanish rider Diego Garrido. With 166 points, Gibert is second in the provisional standings, which are led by James Dabill, with 217. Third is Diego Garrido, with 156 points.
