## Ádam Raga wins in Motegi and remains second at the Trial Outdoor Championship

The GAS GAS rider Ádam Raga won the test in the second day of this World Championship in Japan and kept his second place in the overall classification. The rider with the first place is Toni Bou, who had won the test the day before.

Raga was the rider who best managed to keep going after the rain, which made the tracks quite slippery in the Twing Ring circuit.

But before that, during the first day, Toni Bou got first and won the test. Jeroni Fajardo came after him and ended up second, and Raga joined them on the podium with a third place.

With regard to the other GAS GAS riders, James Dabill ended up sixth both on Saturday and Sunday's tests.

Thus, after the fifth day of races in Japan, the overall classification of this Trial Outdoor World Championship has rider Toni Bou on the first place of the podium, with 92 points. Raga has 80 and goes second.

The Championship will continue on June 26th in Great Britain.
